





Hello Everyone! Lots of things have been happening at the Moose especially in the kitchen and we have a few exciting things coming up as we enter Wisconsin winter.

New kitchen events coming up for the holidays include a Holiday Brunch on Dec.1 and a Holiday Cocktail Party for *Members and Their Guests* on Dec. 14th. We hope to see you all at one of these events (or possibly both - lots of yummy food to be had!) Also, the annual dinner for the Kings Vets on Dec. 13th will be a buffet this year!

Now, over the past couple of weeks I have heard a few questions about what I do for the lodge, my personal catering business, etc. I would like to take this time to answer some of these questions (feel free to personally ask me as well).

Q: What's my role at the Moose 1572?

A: In 2017, I was hired to take the role as the kitchen manager working approximately 20 hours per week. My duties include hiring, training, scheduling and maintaining staff as well as covering shifts as needed; creating monthly special menus as well as maintaining a regular menu and ensuring items are priced properly; ordering and keeping inventory on product (I have cut down on vendors due to order minimums so most product I personally pick up; cleaning and maintenance of the kitchen; holding a valid Food Safety Manager license as well as representing the lodge during health inspections; keeping morale high among kitchen staff; and cooking the majority of Friday fish fries. I also have been doing some social media posting for the lodge as well as creating events to encourage the public to come and visit. In return, I am paid and have access to the kitchen for my personal catering business, Dilly Dahl Deli with the Lodge/Chapter having first access. I have turned down opportunities that did not fit in the schedule with Mark, the WOTM and the House Committee sets.

Q: How do members know what hours Amy is working as a lodge employee or working for her deli?

A: I keep a record of what hours are "lodge hours" on a phone application - I am happy to show and explain via a request through the House Committee. Most of the personal business hours occur in the morning to early afternoon and I do assist with the lodge when asked during my business prep time. I do not receive financial compensation from the lodge to operate my business, nor is anyone helping or hanging out with me.

Q: How do we keep the Lodge's and the Deli's inventory separate?

A: The deli has designated shelves in the dry goods area, a shelf in the stand-up freezer and an area in the walk in cooler that I keep my personal deli items on. The menus for the deli differ from the lodge so there is very little room to confuse which entity owns which product. However, the lodge and the deli have a solid working relationship where the lodge has used my deli items

at no cost and visa-versa. The deli also regularly donates soup for Friday fish fries. Some of my product has also been donated for Packer games when no one has volunteered to bring food.

The deli has been operated from the lodge for the past two and a half years.

If you have any other questions other than the ones I address, please feel free to come and personally ask - unfortunately, it is difficult to answer questions when one hears them ambiguously after the fact.

To finish this newsletter entry, I want everyone to give a warm welcome to our

newest kitchen addition, Jason. He has been training in the kitchen to provide exciting specials on the Tuesday and Wednesday grill nights.

We also want to wish the best to Miss Chloe - she has been an asset to our team since before I came along but has moved on to a new job experience. We wish her the best and look forward to seeing her around whenever she comes to visit. In addition, a special thank you to Chrissy for filling in on some waitressing shifts the past few weeks - you rock!

The next time you'll hear from the kitchen will be in the New Year, so we wish you the best of holidays as we go through November and December and hope you have a chance to take a break out of the hustle to stop by the Moose. As always, if you have any questions
